CADASIL Study – New York University is no longer enrolling new participants as the study is closed, July 6, 2011.

Thank you to everyone who participated in this study. New York University School of Medicine, Division of Neurogenetics was conducting a research study for patients with CADASIL. The purpose of this study was to better understand the early symptoms of CADASIL so doctors may learn to diagnose it early. Specific aims: Characterize the nature, frequency and severity of migraine in patients with CADASIL, Delineate the phenomenon of acute confusional migraine as a distinct subgroup of migraine and establish its prevalence in patients with CADASIL and Determine the latency between the onset of neurological symptoms including migraine, and diagnosis of CADASIL and the prevalence of misdiagnosis. Principal Investigator was Dr. Sathe, NYU School of Medicine, and Division of Neurogenetics. We are honored to have Dr. Sathe on the CADASIL TWHH Scientific Advisory Committee and she was the Chairperson for the first USA CADASIL symposium and CADASIL family conference in July 2010.
